

DRY VAN TRAILERS FACT SHEET

RYDER COMMERCIAL TRAILERS

Over the Road (OTR) Trailers

Typically new to 10 years old, more than 40K miles

Designed for the long haul, 53' trailers are manufactured for medium- to high-volume shipments between warehouses, factories, and distribution centers to job sites, stores, and event locations.

Cartage Trailers

Typically mid-Life, between 10K and 20K miles, short-term hauls

Specialized for short-distance deliveries, Ryder's 53' dry van cartage trailers are ideal for the transportation of non-perishable goods.

Storage Trailers

End of life, no miles, cost effective/conscious

Ideal for mobile inventory management, storage trailers offer temporary warehousing solutions with weather-protected security for items. Due to their widespread availability and adaptability, these efficient, cost-effective trailers are compatible with most loading docks, forklifts, and pallet jacks.

APPLICATION AND TYPICAL AGE OVERVIEW

- Standard Ryder - 53'dry van trailer without a lift gate
- Used Trailers Golden Years are mid-life to end-of-life
- OTR used trailers can be redeployed units but all storage and cartage trailers will be mid-life or end of life units.
- Miles: OTR more than 40k miles; cartage 10k to 20k mileage; storage no miles
- Typical Model Years: 0 to 10 – OTR; 8 to 15 – Cartage (Local/Regional Use); 8 to 40 – Storage

INDUSTRIES SERVED

Over the Road Trailers:

- **Retailers and Manufacturers:** dry, over the road trailers transport consumer goods like clothing, electronics, furniture, appliances, and packaged foods to warehouses, distribution centers, and stores
- **Logistics Companies:** third-party logistics (3PL) providers and shipping companies utilize OTR trailers as a core component of their freight transportation services, catering to a wide range of industries
- **E-commerce Companies:** OTR trailers help e-commerce businesses move goods between fulfillment centers, distribution hubs, and sorting facilities for parcel delivery
- **Construction and Industrial Companies:** used to transport building supplies, industrial materials, auto parts, and equipment that do not require specialized temperature control or oversized handling
- **Construction/Remodeling:** transport building materials, tools, and equipment at job sites
- **Food and Beverage:** move non-perishable packaged foods and beverages
- **Hospitals and Healthcare:** transport medical supplies and equipment
- **Postal/Bulk Mail:** deliver multiple volumes of mail and packages

Cartage Trailers:

- **Local & Regional Freight Carriers (FB/TM):** offer quick load/unload capabilities for short-distance deliveries and pickup routes, minimizing costly downtime
- **Third-Party Logistics Providers (3PLs):** offer scalability and integration with logistics systems for last-mile delivery, cross-docking, and regional distribution
- **Retail Distribution Centers:** move goods from distribution centers to stores or between locations
- **Manufacturers:** transport raw materials or finished goods between plants or to local partners
- **Courier & Parcel Delivery Services:** lightweight cartage trailers provide couriers with fast turnaround in urban or suburban areas on short-haul deliveries
- **Construction & Industrial Firms:** offer rugged reliability to handle heavy loads and rough terrain when moving equipment or materials between job sites

Storage Trailers:

- **Retail and Wholesale:** used for managing seasonal overstock, promotional materials, or expanding inventory without increasing permanent warehouse space
- **Manufacturing and Warehousing:** used for storing raw materials, finished goods, or overflow inventory. Helps buffer inventory by providing temporary warehousing
- **Construction/Remodeling:** storage trailers hold building materials, tools, and equipment at job sites
- **Food and Beverage:** store non-perishable packaged foods and beverages
- **Hospitals and Healthcare:** provide additional space for medical supplies and equipment
- **Postal/Bulk Mail:** handle large volumes of mail and packages
- **Tradeshows and Conventions:** store displays, equipment, and promotional materials
- **Events and Entertainment:** offer secure, mobile, and temporary storage for staging equipment, props, and supplies
- **Government Agencies:** provide temporary storage and mobile office needs during emergencies or public events
- **Schools and Universities:** manage space constraints during renovations or expansions
- **Emergency & Disaster Relief Agencies:** provide fast availability, mobility, and rugged construction for rapid supply deployment and mobile storage in crisis zones
